Bernardo Bortolotti

Executive Director, Transition Investment Lab, NYUAD

Bernardo Bortoloti is Executive Director of the Transition Investment Lab at NYUAD, Professor in economics at the University of Turin (on leave) and Director of the Sovereign Investment Lab at Bocconi University in Milan. His research focuses on the complex relationships between state and markets, with special emphasis on state ownership of firms, regulation, corporate finance, and corporate governance. He is one of the leading international experts in privatization, state-assets management and divestiture, and sovereign wealth funds.

His work appeared in major academic economics and finance journals, and he has published two books with Oxford University Press. He has been Executive Director of Fondazione Eni Enrico Mattei. He has advised the World Bank, the Initiative for Policy Dialogue, the Italian Ministry of the Economy as secretary of the Global Advisory Committee on Privatization, the Italian Audit Office, listed firms and public and private financial institutions. He received his PhD in economics from the Université Catholique de Louvain.



Martin Jakob Nagell

Martin Jakob Nagell is the Director of Responsible Investing at Mubadala, where he guides the firm's sustainable investment strategies and oversees the integration of value based management across Mubadala's global portfolio. Her leadership also encompassed several landmark initiatives, such as infrastructure debt partnerships with IFC (2017, 2022), the Emerging Africa Infrastructure Fund investment (2018), the Allianz Asia Private Credit strategy (2019), the MIGA COVID-19 Response Program (2020), and the USD 1.1 billion SDG Loan Fund (2023).

Nadia began her career at Citigroup in London and brings a strong track record in scaling impact strategies and mobilising capital to advance sustainable development.
